Dear Minister,

I write in relation to the lack of school bus services to transport students from Edmondson Park to the newly-opened Denham Court Public School.

I understand Transport for NSW is yet to approve a school bus service to ensure children can get to and from school within the catchment area for Denham Court Public School, which extends to Edmondson Park.

Bluntly, this is a complete failure to plan for adequate services for communities in south-west Sydney.

In my submission when the school was in planning stages, I made it clear it would be ludicrous to open a school without adequate bus services. Unfortunately, the Liberal Government has chosen to ignore the needs of local students.

Of course, parents would not be experiencing this issue if the Liberal Government had built a new school in Edmondson Park when it was first needed years ago.

Nonetheless, there is a glaringly obvious hole in bus services required to service Denham Court Public School students.

I request that the Liberal Government rectify the situation urgently. I look forward to your urgent advice on this matter.
